I am writing to make an open government request for all the information to which I am entitled under the freedom of information act. In order to assist you with this request, I am outlining my query as specifically as possible

I am requesting the following information:

A full copy of the review carried out by the Norfolk and Suffolk NHS Foundation Trust into Alexander Kerry following the murder of Pauline King at her home in The Avenues, Norwich, on February 22 2015.

The EDP and Norwich Evening News understands that a review was carried out by the Norfolk and Suffolk NHS Foundation Trust into the way it dealt with Mr Kerry who had been transferred into the trust's inpatient services from Cornwall earlier in 2015 and who was held for assessment under Section 2 of the Mental Health Act.

I understand that under the act, I should be entitled to the information within 20 working days. I would be grateful if you could confirm via email that you have received this request. Ideally I would like the information outlined in my request emailed to me. I look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
